

PART 139 SELF INSPECTOR TRAINING, OVERVIEW AND PRACTICAL PROGRAM

The Pacific Region Aviation Training Center (PRATC) is pleased to present the Airport Operations – Self Inspection Training Course, May 25 – 29, 2015. The curriculum has been developed based on the Advisory Circulars, reviewed and approved by the Hawaii Airport District Office. This program is designed to educate and challenge airport personnel with Part 139 roles and responsibilities.

All sessions will take place at the Pacific Region Aviation Training Center. The course will begin at 8 a.m. (registration opens at 7:30 a.m.) on Monday, May 25. The registration fee includes five (5) continental breakfasts, five (5) lunches, refreshment breaks and all handouts. Dress is business casual. Confirmation letters will be emailed to attendees.
